#### Portfolio : - 5 Marks

#### Subject Enrichment Activities : - 5 Marks

1. Languages aim at developing effective listening and speaking skills.
2. Mathematics includes Lab Activities.
3. Science includes practicals, surveys and activities.

#### Periodic Test : - 5 Marks

1. Students will be assessed using subjective and objective questions.
2. One test of 30 marks each will be conducted in each term.
3. These tests will be conducted in, Term – I (July), Term – II (January).
4. The final weightage will be of 5 marks.

#### Multiple Assessments (Assignments / Worksheets / Puzzles / MCQs) : - 5 Marks

1. Two multiple Assessments of 20 marks each will be conducted in each term.
2. These will be conducted in Term – I (July, August), Term – II (November, February).
3. The average of two assessments will be taken and then reduced to 5 marks.
